Level: 2nd class (16 years old)

Date: March 2018

We decided to put in practice the Iceland's activity "Access to normal life"

Justification and description of the activity:



- Three groups of 3 4 students explored the accessibility for disabled people to schools, public buildings, banks and so forth.
- Goal is to understand difficulties of people with disabilities to participate in city life.
- The results of students' research will be presented to local authorities.

Sequence of activities:

- Discussion about the rights of all in social life.
- Exploration of difficulties faced by disabled people to participate in city life.
- Mobilization to solve problems.







Impact of the activity

This activity gave the students the opportunity:

- ✓ To tighten their relationships.
- ✓ To realize that we all have the right to participate in city life.
- ✓ To raise awareness on issues related to people with disabilities.
- ✓ To be mobilized in order to solve problems facing people with disabilities on their access to city life.
